



## PREACHING TIPS

Below Are Just Some "Tips" on Preparing and Delivering for Minister's

1. **To prepare:** Have a "Topic" or "Thought" Steep yourself in the "Topic" until you have a point
2. **Study & Pray:** Study and Pray on your Topic after God gives it to you, or you come up with one your self (God will not always give you one, so you will still have to be ready)
3. **Know where you: are going with the Topic, Have an introduction, Summary, and the Conclusion. Into with something in the Natural that has something to do with the spiritual that you are getting ready to feed the Saints. Then sum your message up to the Point, and then make the Conclusion to end.**
4. **To practice:** Practice on some live person (*Like your wife*) what you want to say.
5. **Make eye contact with specific people.** Address *them*.
6. **Don't go on autopilot.** Stay in what you're Topic is
7. **Don't try to do anything special with your hands:** Release them to move as they will.
8. **Pause:** often on purpose, let the "Preacher" use you (*Which is the Holy Ghost*)
9. **Be ready:** (2 Timothy 4:2) *preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all long suffering and doctrine.* If you are a "Guest" at a Church always be Ready "To Preach" Never, and I mean **Never** say I do not have anything to Preach. We as Ministers of God should always have something to say or preach. God is too wonderful and great for us to say I have nothing to Preach at anytime. We may not feel good that day or night, but as Timothy said we must be "Instant in season & out of Season" when we feel good or when we do not.

**10. Doctrine:** If or when you are a Visiting or Guest Speaker, try not to Preach on Doctrine (Pastoral Message) unless God puts it on your Heart to do so. This should be up to the Pastor to deliver a Pastoral Message.

Please Note: The above is only a guideline and tips on preaching to help the Young Minister in their Ministry. The young Minister has a lot of Pressure so this is to help them along the way; My Pastor had a young “Minister's” Teaching class to help the minister not make the same mistakes he made when he first started out in the ministry. But make no Mistake you will have problems at some point in your Ministry, things like losing your train of thought, or if you wear glasses your glasses falling off. So I hope and pray that these will help you along your way and may God bless and keep you all in your walk with our God.
